* Baptism Notes For Parents

- 1. Parent(s) must be registered Parishioners of Immaculate Conception Parish for at least 6 months, regularly attending Sunday Mass.
- 2. Parent(s) will complete the Baptismal Worksheet. Per Diocesan guidelines, a copy of the Birth Certificate of the child / person being baptized, must also be provided. (We understand this may take several weeks... please send a copy <u>as soon as possible</u>, so the Baptismal Record can be completed and the baby can received his/her Baptismal Certificate.

Additionally, the Parish will reimburse the cost of the Birth Certificate, simple send in a copy of the receipt along with the copy of the Birth Certificate)

- 3. Choosing Godparent(s):
 - -Must be at least 16 years of age
- -Must be practicing Catholic(s)
- -If not IC Parishioner, must provide a Letter of Good-Standing (LOGS) from home Parish
- -If there are 2 Godparents, one must be Male, the other, Female
- -If Godparents are unable to attend the Baptism, Proxy Godparents are allowed, with the same credentials as above, except a LOGS is not required (if you don't have Proxys, the Parish can assist you).
- 4. Parent(s) will coordinate the Date/Time of the Baptism with the Priest at least one week in advance.
- 5. All parties should arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled time of Baptism and be properly attired (Sunday Best + modesty guidelines).
- 6. Baptismal Candle and white bib are provided by the Parish.

 Baptismal certificate will be available once all information has been properly documented. Generally, the Baptismal certificate will be hand-delivered to the parents.
- 7. An appropriate honorarium is generally given to the Priest/Altar Server after the Baptism
